- Read these instructions.

The system heat vents, located at the front and the rear, dissipate heat. Do not block these openings. Leave at least 5 inches of space at the front and the rear of the switch for proper ventilation. Be reminded that without proper heat dissipation and air circulation, system components might overheat, which could lead to system failure or even severely damage components.

- To prevent your product from overheating, do not operate it in an area that exceeds the maximum recommended ambient temperature of 50°C for the GigaCore 30i and for the GigaCore 30i with PoE.

POWER CABLE:

Use only approved power cables. If you have not been provided with a power cable for your system or for any AC powered option intended for your system, purchase a power cable that is approved for use in your country. The power cable must be rated for the product and for the voltage and current marked on the product's electrical ratings label. The voltage and current rating of the cable should be greater than the ratings marked on the product.

DISCONNECT DEVICE:

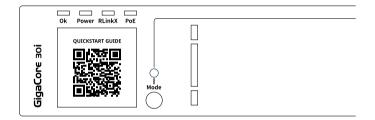

QUICKSTART GUIDE

Welcome to your GigaCore 30i.

Upon unpacking your new GigaCore, the E-ink display will display a QR-code. After scanning this QR-code, the safety manual and quick start guide will be opened on the device used for scanning. Once the device has been powered up and booted, this QR-code will disappear and not come back on a following bootup.

1. INSTALLING/REMOVING PSU's

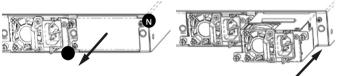
The GigaCore 30i is equiped with two slots for slide-in power supply units (PSU).

MOUNTING A PSU

- Slide a PSU, suitable for your setup, in PSU slot 1 (left-hand slot). Make sure the label is at the top!
- Secure the PSU with the thumb screw fasteners.

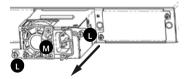
MOUNTING A SECOND PSU

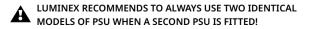
- Remove the M3x10 TX10 screws (N), holding the blindplate.
- Remove the blindplate.
- Slide the second PSU in PSU slot 2 (right-hand side).
- Secure the PSU with the thumb screw fastener.



REMOVE A PSU:

- Unscrew the thumb screw fastener (L) by turning them anti-clockwise.
- Use the bracket (M) to slide the PSU out of the main device as shown in the image below.



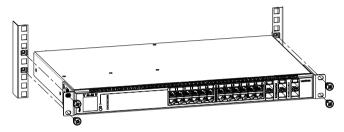

2. MOUNTING THE DEVICE

2.1 Rack mount

In case you want to mount your GigaCore 30i in a standard 19-inch rack, you need 4 rack screws to mount the device.



3. POWER UP THE DEVICE

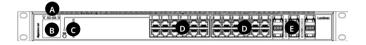
Power-up the device with a power cable with IEC connection (J) (please contact your local dealer if you don't have a suitable power cable on hand). The device will automatically switch on. To shut it down after use, just un-plug the power cable again.



After connecting the power cable correctly, the power LED indicator on the front panel will light up green. The GigaCore 30i requires standard AC power distribution from 100-240VAC, 50/60Hz. Current required depends on the model. Please use an IEC plug compliant cable to power the device. Luminex recommends the use of a power cable fitted with a locking mechanism to ensure a reliable connection to the device.

4. DESCRIPTION

4.1 Front Panel



(A) Status LEDs:

- OK: Indicates the general status of the switch.
- PoE: Indicates the status of the PoE functionality and the PoE supplies (GigaCore 30i with PoE only).
- RLinkX: Indicates the RLinkX status.
- Power: Indicates the status of the power supply.

(B) E-ink Display:

 E-ink display: Indocates the options the switch has and the IP address (unless disabled in the settings).

(C) Mode:

- Mode LED: Indicates the selected state for the Mode LEDs (see the "LED indicators" section in this manual for more details).
- Mode button: Use this button to browse through the different states of the port Mode LEDs.

(D) RJ45 ports:

24x RJ45 10/100/1000Mbs port.

(E) SFP:

6x SFP+ cage for Mini-GBIC transceiver.

4.2 Rear Panel



(F) Serial port:

1x RS232 console port on USB-C.

(G) LED Extension Port:

1x LED extension port for optional LED panel on USB-C.

(H) Fans:

3x Fan.

(I) Power:

Options for up to 2x slide-in power supply.

5. LED INDICATORS

There are various LEDs on the GigaCore 30i. Here is a list of the LEDs, the possible colours, and the meaning of each colour:

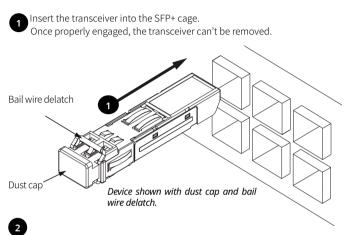

With the use of the mode button, the user can get all the necessary information immediately. Press the mode button to browse through the different states.

6. INSTALLING SFP+ TRANSCEIVERS

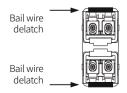
The GigaCore 30i is equiped with six SFP+ cages at the front of the unit.

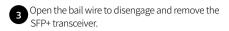


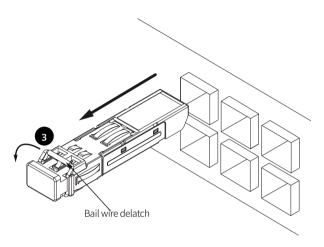
Be aware of the insertion direction:

port 25, 27 and 29 must have the bail wire delatch on the top.

port 26, 28 and 30 must have the SFP+ transceiver upside-down.







For any other model of SFP+ transceiver, please refer to the transceiver manual.

7. CONNECTING TO THE WEB INTERFACE

- The default GigaCore IP address is displayed at the rear of the unit. Set your computer with a compliant IP address (do not use the same IP address!).
- Connect your computer to the GigaCore with a network cable.
- Launch your favourite web browser.
- Type the IP address of the switch in the address field followed by enter.

PLEASE KEEP IN MIND THE WEB INTERFACE OF A SWITCH CAN ONLY BE REACHED THROUGH A PORT ASSIGNED IN THE MANAGEMENT GROUP (FROM THE SWITCH YOU'RE CONNECTED TO, OR FROM ANOTHER SWITCH THROUGH AN ISL PORT). YOU NEED AT LEAST ONE PORT ASSIGNED TO THE MANAGEMENT GROUP IN YOUR ENTIRE NETWORK TO REACH THE WEB INTERFACE OF ALL YOUR GIGACORE SWITCHES

FACTORY DEFAULT ALL PORTS ARE ASSIGNED TO THE MANAGEMENT GROUP.

8. RESET

Sometimes it can come in handy to reset the device. To do this, press and hold the mode button for 10 seconds. Once the four status LEDs blink red, release the button. This will reset all settings to default. The user profiles will be preserved though.
